Dean's Update	 The budget for 2015-2016 is already being discussed. Forecasting has begun earlier than in the past and is headed toward a more responsibility-based budget model. USF may not have business system to implement by July. Legislature-support for performance-based funding. We look good, but not sure what other universities look like at this point. We will ask for more funding USF/UCF/FIU coalition- \$12M will be distributed equally and run out of UCF campus. College of Medicine is in the early stages of being built in downtown Tampa. Can we align with STEM? STEAMM has been proposed to include the arts and music. Innovative Education-Classes were held over the winter break (480 students enrolled). Information is being gathered on the success rate of this new approach. Enrollment is down resulting in lower SCH. Head count is down by 5% for undergraduates.
