|                                | organizations and is pretty generous (somewhere around \$1,600)                 |        |
|                                | if they apply. For those students who attended this year, they                  |        |
|                                | really enjoyed themselves which was great.                                      |        |
|                                | > The strategic planning groups have met once so far.                           |        |
|                                | We are now soliciting feedback from the Fall Assembly from the                  |        |
|                                | faculty.  |        |
| Report of                      | > At the meeting last week, April Turley and Miguel Taveras were                |        |
| Research Council               | invited to speak about the services their office (Technology                    |        |
|                                | Transfer/Patents & Licensing) provides and provide clarification                |        |
|                                | on one of the metrics listed as a goal for the college to meet for              |        |
|                                | 2016-17. We learned that this college has more copyrights than                  |        |
|                                | patents. And some of the patents that our faculty are a part of                 |        |
|                                | are not reported for this college because the first inventor is                 |        |
|                                | from another college (i.e. Medicine and Engineering).                           |        |
|                                | > We hope that as a result of this presentation and clarification of            |        |
|                                | what activities/products should be included, more disclosures                   |        |
|                                | will be submitted and counted toward out BOG metric goal.                       |        |
|                                | Essentially, we they want you to consider if the product can be commercialized. |        |
|                                | > There is one faculty member currently completing the I-Corp                   |        |
|                                | program/training. NIH is starting a similar program in the near                 |        |
|                                | future.   |        |
|                                | > There were no international travel applications for this cycle, but           |        |
|                                | the internal grant applications are due Friday, Nov. 4 <sup>th</sup> .          |        |
| Associate Dean's               | > The tenure and promotion process is underway. There were only                 |        |
| Report                         | 12 applications (as opposed to the 15 previously reported).                     |        |
|                                | > The university is considering the purchase of a new enrollment                |        |
|                                | system. The currently used system, BANNER, is no longer able to                 |        |

|                | accommodate the significant changes that need to be made. One                          |

|                | issue is that the information transferred conflicts from one                           |
|                | campus to another (i.e. availability of courses across campus).                        |
|                | ➤ There are now 8 study abroad programs, with a possible 9 <sup>th</sup>               |
|                | program in the works. Student scholarships have been                                   |
|                | established to fund students based on their financial needs. USF                       |
|                | is very interested in collaborations with Criminology. If                              |
|                | interested, please contact Study Abroad. Dr. Batsche can assist                        |
|                | with contacts in that office.  |
|                | > In regard to academic integrity, there is a new provision that has                   |
|                | not been enforced (mainly because the faculty may not know).                           |
|                | All incidents should be reported centrally even if it has been                         |
|                | resolved with the student directly so it can be tracked. We should                     |
|                | be using the "3 strikes you're out" method. When all incidents                         |
|                | get reported, a student can be escalated if they are repeat                            |
|                | offenders. To report, please let Dr. Batsche know of the incident.                     |
|                | If you have any questions, please contact your Department Chair                        |
|                | (who will refer to Dr. Batsche if there is a need to consult).                         |
| CBCS Diversity | The student survey was sent out this semester. There were 185                          |
| Committee      | responses from 2500 students. Most respondents were students                           |
|                | from Criminology, Communication Sciences & Disorders, Mental                           |
|                | Health Law & Policy, and Social Work. The averages were pretty                         |
|                | high and were on a scale 1-5. There was no score lower than a 3.                       |
|                | The lowest score of 2.5 was for the question asking if the                             |
|                | leadership reflects diversity.   |
