Dean's Report – Dr. Julianne Serovich	 The Provost recently visited CBCS, interacted with leadership, Faculty, Staff, and students, and shared his goal of actively working to improve the USF research infrastructure and grant management process. The University has decided to implement a new budget model and abandoned the RCM budget model. Faculty recruitment may be impacted again this academic year. We should be aggressive with faculty searches. Embedded HR and Fiscal services continue with the implementation. 	
Associate Dean's Report – Dr. Jennifer Lister	 CBCS awarded 23 Study Abroad Scholarships. Students will be tracked to ensure commitment to a trip. Usually, there are a few who do not, which may result in another call for scholarship applications in early spring to fill any empty slots. CBCS awarded 8 Undergraduate Research Assistantships for Spring 2024. Almost all were students in CSD, and one was from Criminology. CBCS has awarded 3 Undergraduate Research Scholarships so far. Due to requests for more time, the applications remain open, and a few more applications are expected to come in. There will be an announcement of any additional scholarship winners in early spring.
